* The vehicles were originally commissioned by the Operational Services Group of the Harmond Co. and subsequently sold as indicated. A vehicle of this type was commissioned in February, 1962 and subsequently sold to Granada Television in November, 1963. The Operational Services Group then had a replacement vehicle capable of accommodating 6 - MK. IV Camera Channels or 3 - Colour Camera Channels. This was subsequently sold to R.T.C. Tunisia with 4 - MK. VI Cameras fitted. In October, 1965, a new vehicle was commissioned by Operational Services Group which is capable of accommodating 8 - MK. V monochrome or 6 - MK. VII Colour Cameras. This vehicle in turn was sold in January, 1967 to Rediffusion Television with 4 - MK. V Camera Channels being replaced by a similar vehicle to accommodate up to 6 - MK. VII Colour Camera Channels or 8 or more MK. V. Channels. This new vehicle was commissioned in September, 1968 and shown at the International Broadcasting Convention in London in late September, 1968. It was subsequently been sold to Moscow Television (see vehicle No. 68 in list).
