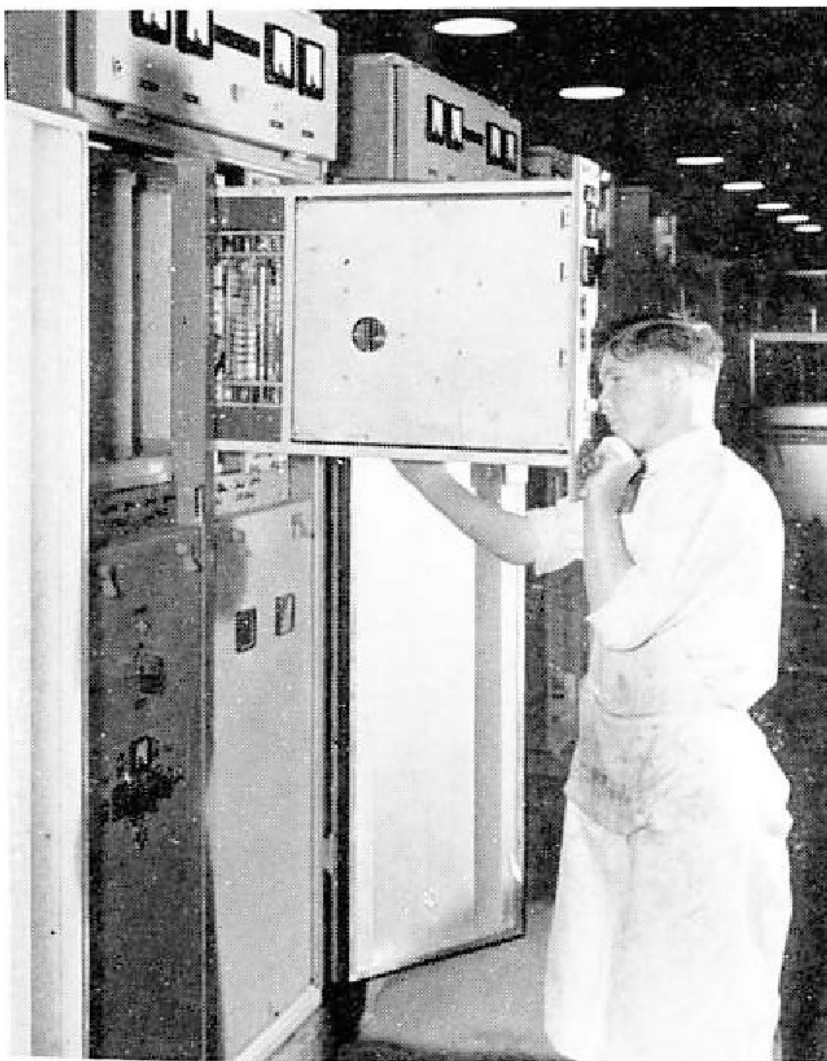

Four Channel Transmitters



THE CONDENSERS which you have seen on the front cover being assembled by Dave Ball in Section 16 are built into the Radio Frequency Units of the 400-watt Channelised Transmitters. In the picture on the left is a batch of transmitters being assembled in Section 17, and Brian Rowland is pushing a modulating unit into position. The units slide individually into the shelves of the cabinets.

These transmitters have four low power channels which can be used simultaneously and are remotely controlled. They are mainly used for telephony, and provision is made for telegraphy. Two similar equipments have already gone as far afield as Barbados, and Kuwait on the Persian Gulf. Others are going to India, Nigeria, Singapore and Bechuanaland.
