| 01-July-1929 | Leslie Graduates as a Physicist from Southampton University and starts work on TV tubes at GEC Research Labs Wembley |
| 1933 | Leslie worked, at GEC as a research scientist on Cathode Ray Tubes. At some time, probably late 1930s Leslie had associations with and may have worked with John Logie Baird |
| 27-September-1935 | Leslie elected as an Associate Member of the Television Society (subsequently The Royal Television Soc.) |
| 16-January-1936 | Leslie elected as an Associate Member IEE |
| 1940 to 1945 | Leslie worked with GEC developing CRTs for Radar as part of the WW2 Scientific Effort |
| 1944 | Leslie made a Fellow of the Royal Television Society |
| 1946 | Leslie leaves GEC Research Labs and joins Cinema-Television in Lower Sydenham |
| 1949 | Cinema-Television closes and most of the staff joined the Marconi Research Labs with Leslie as Head of TV Research under L.H. Bedford |
| 1956 | Jules Thorn enters into a partnership with Sylvania Labs to form Sylvania-Thorn and Leslie appointed Director Colour TV Research |
| 1962 to 1968 | Leslie moves to USA to work at Westinghouse Colour TV Labs in Pittsburgh |
| 1969 | Leslie returns to UK and takes up a Research Fellowship with Chelsea College, London University , and acts as a consultant to the TV Industry until his retirement |
| 01-August-1988 | Leslie dies |
